Red-throated Diver – *Gavia stellata* (Pontopp.).

Rare passage bird. It is registered only during autumn migration: 4.10.1980 2 birds were feeding near shore of Krestovskiy Island. One bird was observed on Neva River near Petropavlovsk Fortress 2.11.1963 (Mal'chevskiy, Pukinskiy, 1983a).

More than 15 records. 6 records for the last 15 years.

Bel. Palyarnaya gagara.
Status: Very rare vagrant species.
2 records since 1920's.
